Welcome to the 2015 Vermont Winter Postal League, last season we were fortunate to have 15 teams competing in our league from six states with over 115 competitors. It's safe to say with teams from coast to coast we are one of the larger leagues in existence. We are hopeful that this number will continue; and perhaps even continue grow (we expect to add a few more clubs this season). Last year's champion was Albion Sportsman's Association followed by Whitehall, third place went to the Plattsburgh Rough Riders.

The league will kick off the 2015 season in mid-January, with the first week scores due in by January 26th then running for 10 weeks (with one bye week), and will end with match 10 taking place over the weekend of April 11&12th.

We are using a new online system this year. For the first time you will be able to register your team and input your team and individual scores directly you can even view results there too.

The goal of the league is to have fun, make it easy for people to be able to participate, and at the same time give people a venue to compete.

### **“Vermont Winter Postal League” - what it is:**

To consist of 10 matches, 9 of which will be fired on your home range and the scores e-mailed in to the league director and the final match to be fired shoulder to shoulder at the Plattsburgh Rod and Gun Club range.

Special arrangements will be made for clubs who join the league from a distance that would make it impractical to travel for match 10.

NRA small bore rules will apply. Any sights (irons or scope)

#### **Four-Position Division**

The course of fire will be 10 shots per stage, prone, sitting, kneeling and standing at 50 ft. on the A17 target.

#### **Prone Division**

The course of fire is be 40 shots prone fired on the USA-50 targets. Please be sure to include the number of “10”s fired for tie breaking. As a point of reference the USA-50 Targets require the ten ring (dot) to be covered to be considered a “ten”.

#### **Air Rifle / Standing**

The Course of fire is 40 shots Standing on the .177 air rifle, on the AR-5/10 target at 33' or on the A-17 target with small bore or air rifle at 50'

Shooters May fire in one, two or all three divisions however they must register and pay separately for each division they compete in.

Open to teams/clubs and individuals

## Venison Cudighi Recipe:

### Ingredients:

3 pounds ground venison  
7 pounds ground pork  
6 tablespoons salt  
1 teaspoon ground nutmeg  
1/2 teaspoon mace  
1/4 teaspoon cinnamon  
1/2 teaspoon ground cloves  
1/2 cup dry red wine  
3 tablespoons granulated sugar  
2 cloves garlic, minced  
2 teaspoons black pepper

### Directions:

Add garlic to wine. Combine all ingredients with meat and mix well. Shape into patties or stuff into 2-inch casings. Refrigerate for 2 days. Fry patties for sandwiches or crumble and cook for pizza
